## Moving date pushed to December

Regrettably, we have had to postpone our moving date due to delays with the UK Power Networks and the works necessary to connect the new building to the grid. However, as announced, as soon as we have a day set in stone, if we hold your mobile number, we will send you a text with the link to the relocation letter online, or if we don't have your mobile number, we will send you an old fashioned letter.

The delay will not affect our operations, and we will continue to provide the best care to our patients in the challenging winter season in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic.

We continue to receive questions about the availability of parking at the new site. There will be 20 bays available on a first-come-first-served basis. On top of that, there will be designated disabled spaces and a drop off point. We will be publishing a detailed guide on how to get to the practice and a more formal access statement near the opening.

You have also asked about what other services will be available in the new building. Our chronic disease monitoring phlebotomy clinics and neonatal appointments offered by midwives from the Royal Free Hospital will remain unchanged. We will announce the exact location and

the days and times of the clinics just before we move.

On the ground floor, you will find our current neighbours: Whitakers Pharmacy. In addition, Chase Side Dental Practice, an established Independent Dental surgery, will be a new tenant. There will be more information about it in the next newsletter.

### Flu vaccination

We currently run vaccination clinics on Wednesday afternoons and Friday mornings. We hope to complete the programme before we move, so if you are eligible for the jab this year, please get in touch with us to book an appointment as soon as possible. Experts predict that there can be more flu infections this year; therefore, we want to ensure you are well protected. 2 and 3-year-olds can get a nasal vaccine on the routine nurse appointment.

### Arriving at the New Practice

The practice will remain open Monday to Friday, 8:00-18:30. The main entrance is located at the Chase Side. Disabled and fragile patients can access the building directly from the car park. Receptionists downstairs will direct you to the waiting room on the first floor.
